Sue has exhibited in many exhibitions including Spectrum 2004 Parliament House Sydney, Art on the Rocks 2004 and the Royal Institute of Architects Potts Point, Sydney. She was one of six artists to represent the FONAS membership at Sydney ART05.

Sue is Treasurer of Friends of the National Art School in Sydney and co-ordinator of the Ultimo Project Gallery, an artist run space in Marrickville.
